

Innovation in response to need

Model designed in collaboration and co production with all our communities.

- Primary Care Centre
- Street Health Team
- Late Night Clinic for Sex Workers
- Pathway Team
- Intermediate/Respite Facility
- Well Being Centre
- End of Life Care





Innovation in response to need

- CQC Outstanding 2016 2023
- SHT: average 75% increase seen in the uptake of primary care services in the three months after first engagement with street health team
- **Pathway:** 62% reduction in total in-patient and A&E costs estimated £7 million saving in secondary care since the commencement of the service in 2013
- Intermediate Care: yielding £2 to £4 return on £1 spent (Health Economics Evaluation)
- Good multi-disciplinary communication
- Safer Medicines Management
- Effective resettlement to sustainable accommodation
