

## Supporting elderly homeless women

FEHÉR, Boróka - RÁDI, Szilvia



BMSZKI is the largest provider of accommodation services to homeless people in Hungary. 2500 beds in 15 locations. About 1/3 host women.

- 2 women only shelters
- 5 shelters/hostels couples
- Mixed day-centers







#### **Needs Assessment**



- National survey on homeless people since 1999
- First gendered analysis in 2017
  - Women respondents usually 20-24% Shelters, hostels, streets

#### **BUT NOT in**

temporary accommodation for homeless families/mothers with children shelters from violence sofa surfing

BMSZKI women users: 29.6% Referrals to hostels: 34%

Budapest outreach: 31.5% (!)

#### Needs Assessment



- What are the three main problems service users here face that staff should tackle?
  - Cleanliness
  - Conflicts
  - The physical conditions of the service


- Physical and mental health
- Gynecological health and needs
- Children under 18
- Physical needs

In Day centres:

- Cleanliness
- Security, men
- Theft, conflicts in the couple





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# Some specific issues elderly women face



- Abuse
  - modern forms of slavery
  - domestic abuse
- Health
  - Bladder problems
  - Dementia, paranoia
- EU citizens coming for better social services
- Physical accompaniment
- Generational/Digital gap
- Role of children, grandchildren

### Dilemma for staff

- notification of next of kin
- user choice for example with permanent placements
  - o what is their best interest?
  - how long can someone stay at a shelter?
  - what housing options do older women have?
- pushing for a diagnosis and then what?
