Women's housing unit

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Housing first based living

- 28 apartment for women who have experienced homelessness
- Lease to their apartment
- Individual support for daily activities (cleaning, cooking etc.)
- 3 practical nurses, 1 nurse and 1 social counsellour visits once a week
- Independent living but women gather together for breakfast and afternoon coffee
- Some women move to more independent living, but for some women it is their home for rest of their lives



Women's backgrounds

- Repetitive homelessness
- Traumatic history
- Multiple challenges
- Kids has been taking into care
- Prison backgrounds
- A lot of substance abuse
- Low income,
- difficulties to take care their economic











Health issues


- · Schizophrenia, depression, bipolar disorder
- Alkoholism, drug addiction
- ADHD, ADD, autism, mild mental disablities, learning difficulties, obsessive-compulsive disorder
- Diabetes, cardiovascular diseases
- Hepatitis, liver cirrhosis
- Dental problems
- Needs of aid, like rollator
